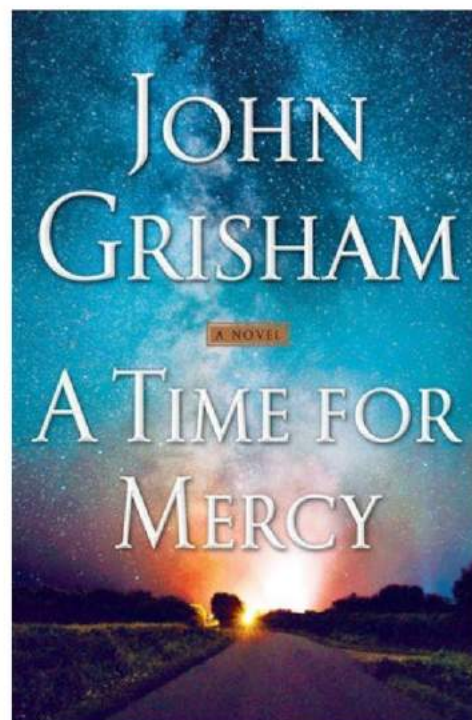
## **THE ONCE AND FUTURE WITCHES**

In the late 1800s, three sisters use witchcraft to change the course of history in a Hugo award-winning author's powerful novel of magic amid the suffragette movement.

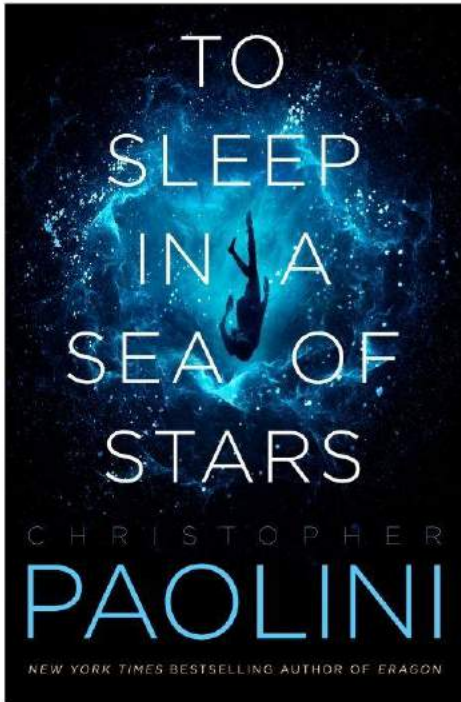
## **A TIME FOR MERCY** **John Grisham**

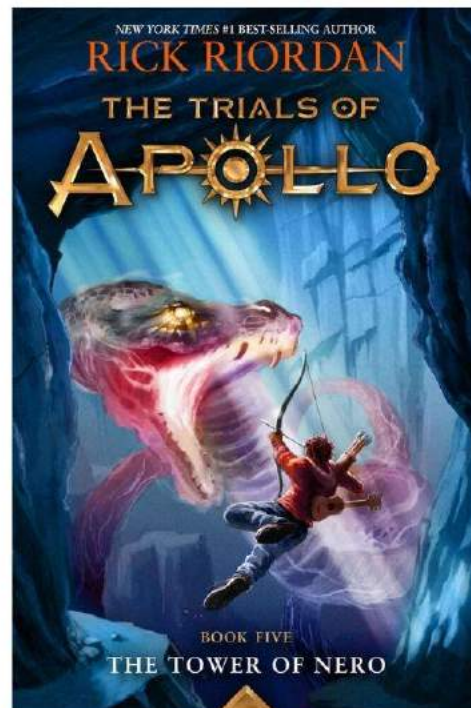


## **TO SLEEP IN A SEA OF STARS Christopher Paolini**

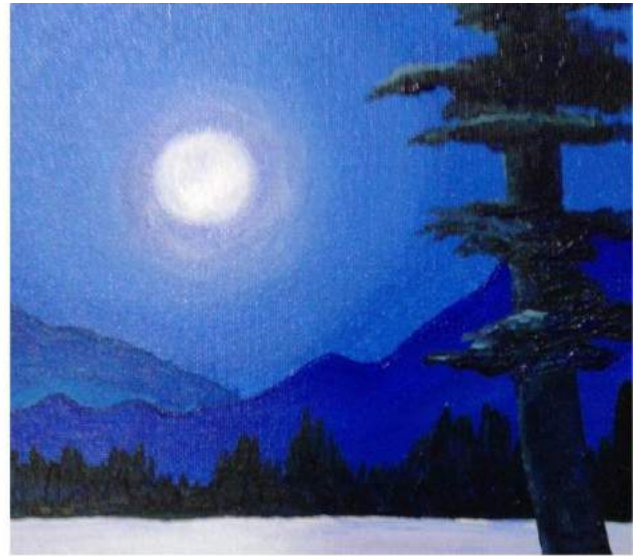
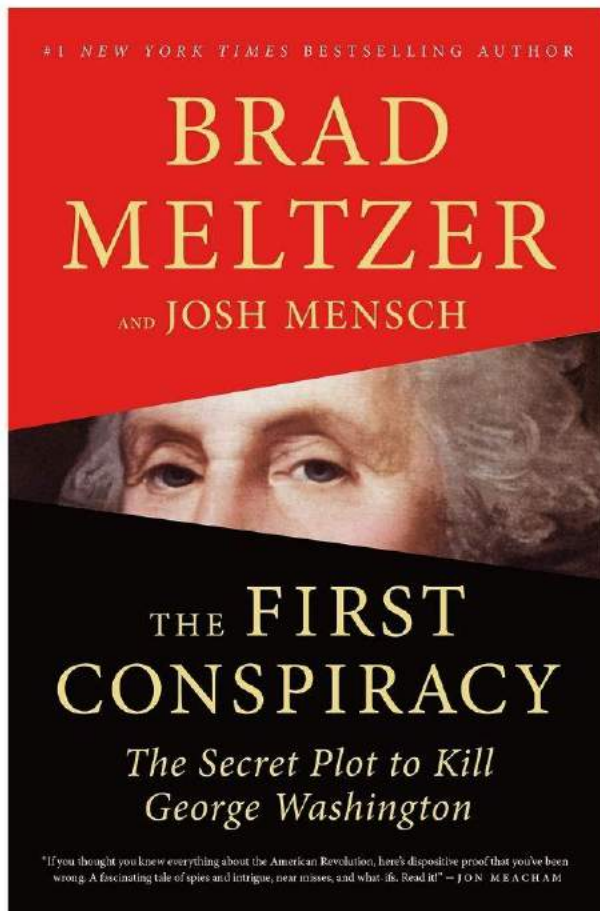
