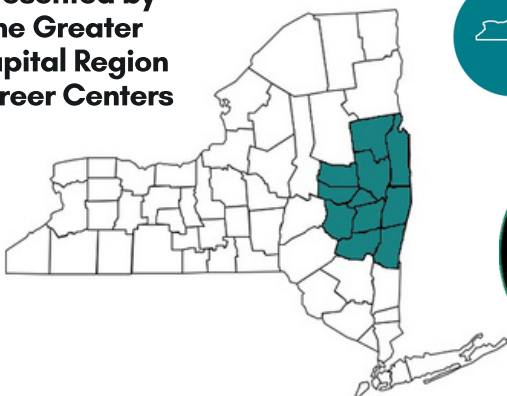
TRANSFERABLE SKILLS

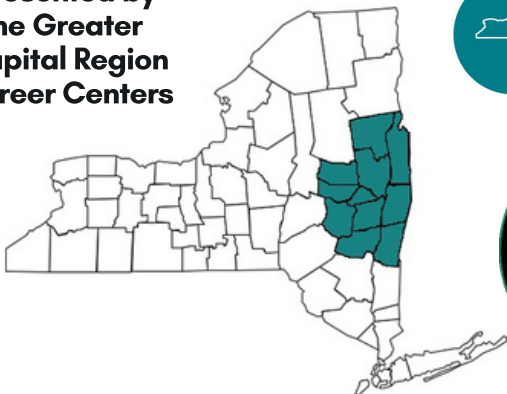

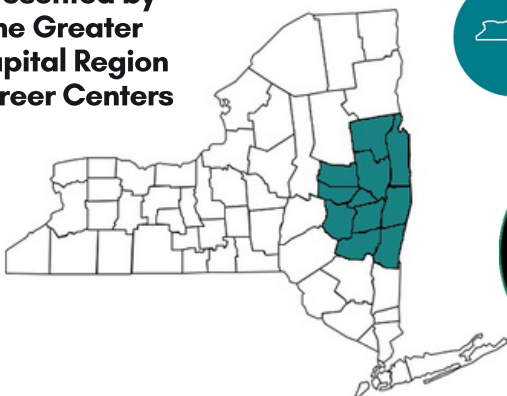
INTERVIEW PREPARATION
