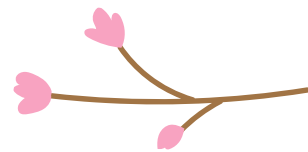

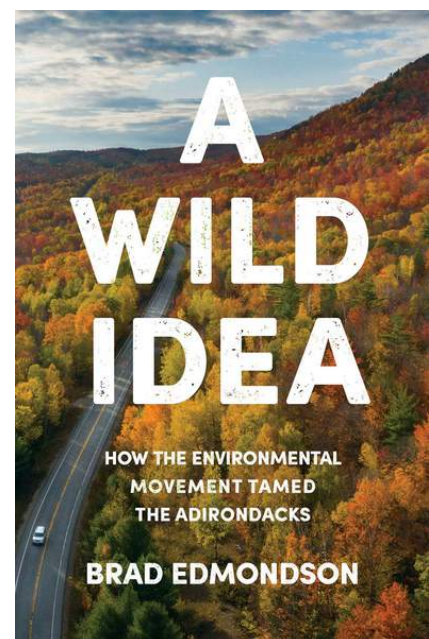

Visit us to learn more information on benefits from our memberships to area museums.

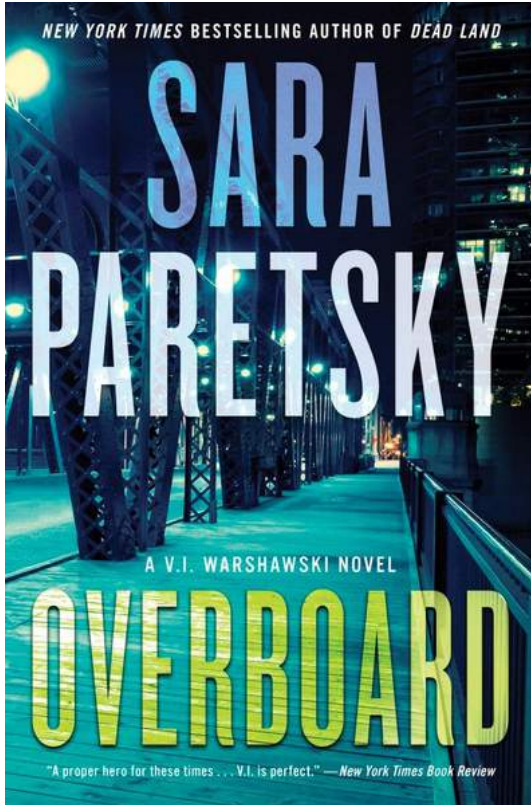

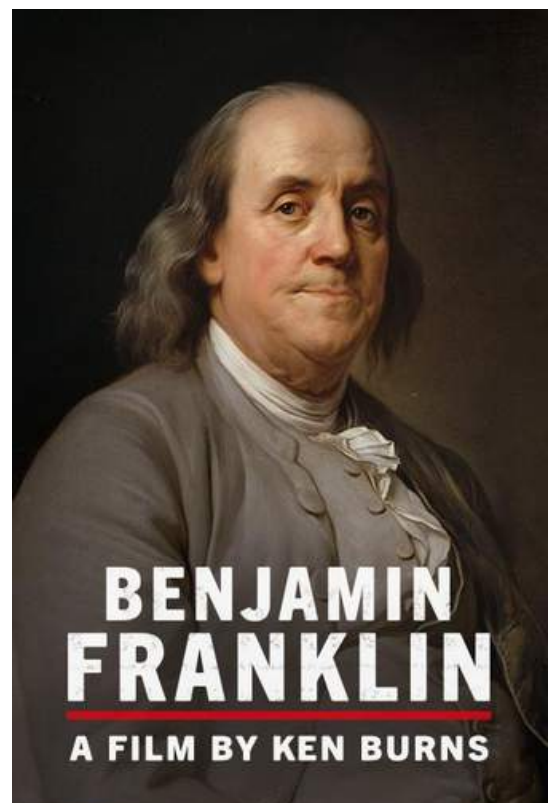
## **WEST SIDE STORY**
