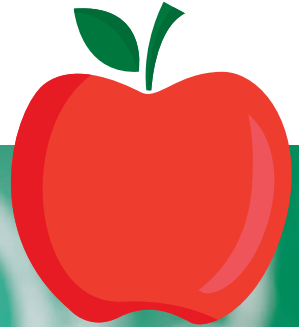

Mechelle Roskiewicz Art Exhibit

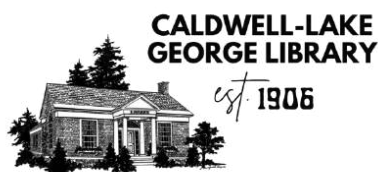

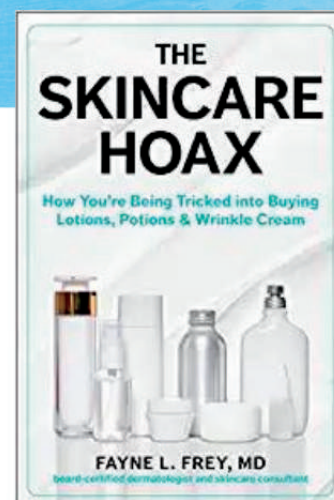


Author Talk

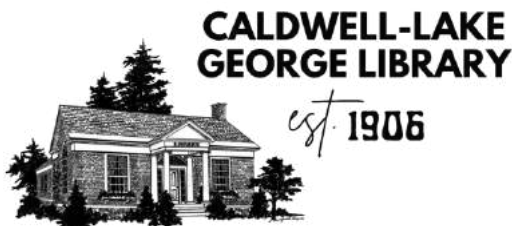
