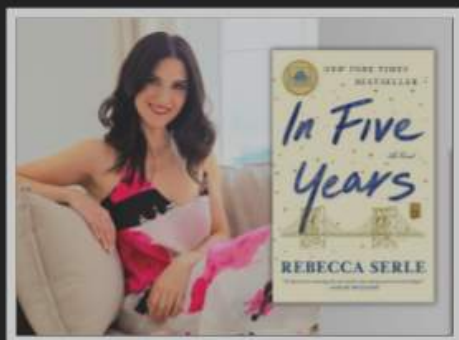

This Project Local exhibition is brought to you in partnership with the Lake George Arts Project. Linda's work will be on display until the end of February.



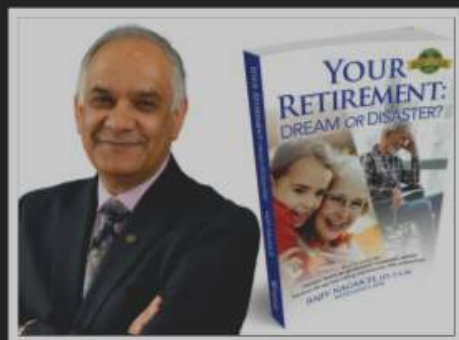

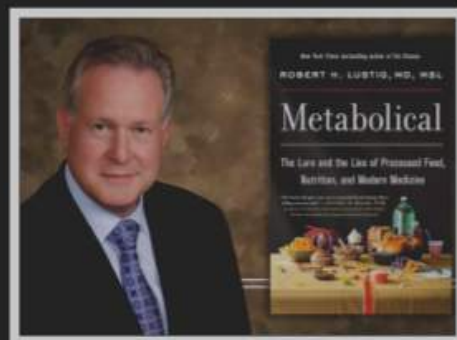

Paint with Patrice

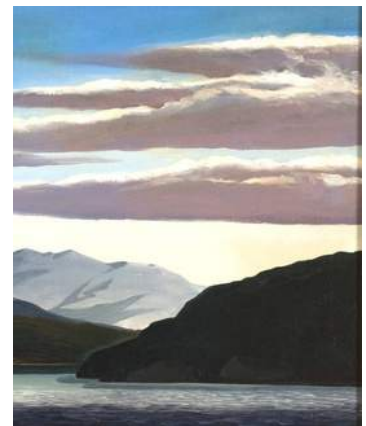
Paint with Patrice

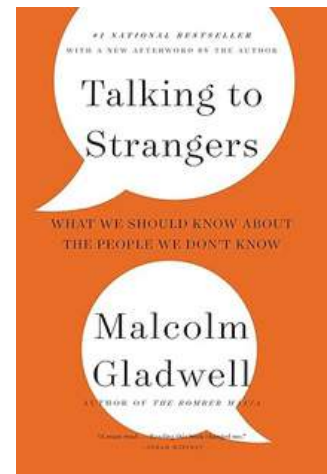

Something is very wrong, Gladwell argues, with the tools and strategies we use to make sense of people we don't know. And because we don't know how to talk to strangers, we are inviting conflict and misunderstanding in ways that have a profound effect on our lives and our world. 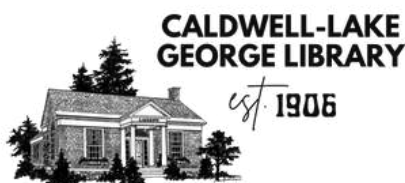
