

In 2023 she had a show titled "Motorpsychedelic" which included thirty of these motorcycle paintings at the Adirondack Lakes Center for the Arts, and one of her paintings, "Lookin" For Adventure," took Second Place Best of Show at the Paul Nigra Center for Creative Arts Fall/Winter Juried Show. Ms. Britton's work will be on display at the library through the end of July. A reception will be held on Tuesday, June 12th at 6:00 pm.
